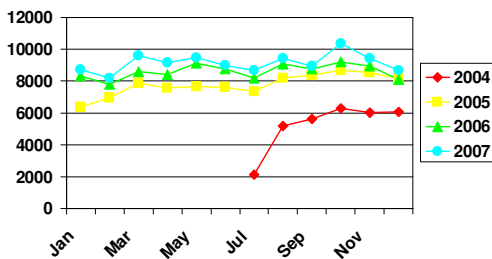

Ride DuPage Ridership



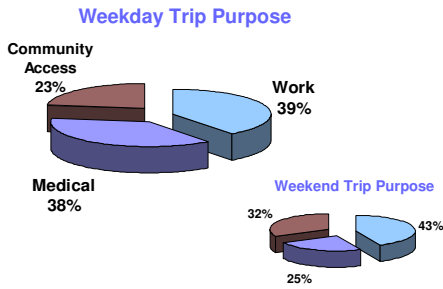

 - Weekend Trips – 8.5%
 - Weekday 6pm to 7am – 11.7%
- October 2007
 - 10,347 trips
 - 1,222 unique addresses
 - Only 358 destinations with more than 10 trips

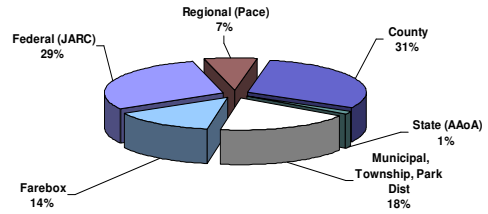
Ride DuPage Mobility Measures

Ride DuPage Funding

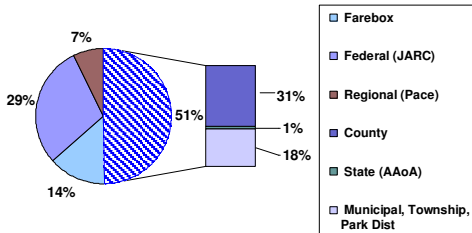
Operating Funding Jan-Dec, 2007
